
Daily Itinerary

Day 1, Friday, September 30: Arrive in Albuquerque today and check into a local hotel. Enjoy a festive welcome dinner at a local restaurant known for the finest in traditional New Mexican cooking and true Southwestern warmth and hospitality. (D)

Day 2, Saturday, October 1: This morning it is up, up, and away bright and early to **Balloon Fiesta Park** and the **Mass Ascension**. Next stop will be at the **Turquoise Museum** for an informative talk on how to buy turquoise. You will then have a guided tour of historic **Old Town**, and enjoy a group lunch. There will be time to shop and explore on your own before watching the Native American dancers at the **Indian Pueblo Cultural Center**. (B/L)

Day 3, Sunday, October 2: Today you travel the **Turquoise Trail Scenic Byway** past former ghost towns to historic **Santa Fe**, the state capital. Once in Santa Fe you can take a guided walking tour of the historic district. The streets are lined with buildings of distinctive design, adobe houses, interesting shops and beautiful churches. We'll visit the world renowned **Loretto Chapel** famous for its miraculous floating staircase and the **Palace of the Governors**. A hosted lunch is included at a local restaurant. Then we will head for the evening's **Balloon Glow** and a buffet dinner at the **Gondola Club**. The Balloon Glow happens when all the balloons fire their burners at the same time creating a spectacular moment. **Fireworks** top off this amazing day. (B/L/D)

Day 4, Monday, October 3: Take a 'flight' on the **Sandia Peak Aerial Tramway** to the top of Sandia Crest. Marvel at the thousands of square miles of breathtaking scenery and panoramic views in all directions. It is then west to **Acoma "Sky City" Pueblo** – the oldest continually inhabited settlement in The United States. Return to Albuquerque for a fun farewell dinner. (B/L/D)
